Just a thought, maybe you could try putting, his bum to the fence, & then asking, just be happy with a step at first, that way the fence is there for support, & he will learn to listen to you cues, & not take charge, do it a few times, then go off & do something he is comfortable with, maybe incorporate it several times in your training session, & see how you get on.

It can be very frustrating, sometimes when they anticipate what you are asking
